Dr. Alex Haddad is an Assistant Professor at Neumann University and teaches in the Doctor of Physical Therapy Program. Dr. Haddad received his DPT degree from Drexel University, after earning a MS in Microbiology from Oregon State University and a PhD in Molecular Genetics and Cellular Biology from The University of Chicago. He also completed an orthopedic residency in physical therapy from Arcadia University, subsequently earning his designation as Board-Certified Clinical Specialist in Orthopaedic Physical Therapy by the American Board of Physical Therapy Specialties.

Dr. Haddad maintains a clinical practice at MossRehab in Philadelphia, where he is senior member of the orthopedic team and faculty member for MossRehab's orthopedic residency program. He is responsible for both didactic instruction, program development, and resident mentorship.

While experienced in treating a wide variety of orthopedic conditions, Dr. Haddad has a particular interest in foot and ankle conditions and the application of observational gait analysis in the clinic, especially as it relates to manual therapy approaches.
