Qualifications:

- Student must be a female enrolled in an undergraduate program.
- Student must have taken at least (12) credits at Neumann University.
- Student must have and maintain a 3.0 Grade point average.
- Student must be enrolled for a minimum of six (6) credits per semester.
- Student must be enrolled in any undergraduate major.
- Student is eligible for a scholarship for a maximum of three years.
- Student must submit an essay demonstrating how the Neumann University Rises are a part of their daily life.
