Jaime L. Howard is the Director of Development for facilities and capital projects for The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP). Her primary responsibilities include planning and overseeing the \$100 million capital campaign for an Ambulatory Care Center that is scheduled to open in 2015 and fundraising activities for additional renovation and construction projects throughout the CHOP network. Additionally, Jaime works closely with donors and institutional partners to build relationships with the Division of Rehabilitation Medicine and on behalf of CHOP-wide programs and initiatives.

Jaime joined CHOP from Temple University, where she was Director of Corporate and Foundation Relations from 2004 through 2010. She oversaw the university's corporate and foundation relations strategic and financial plan for 17 schools and colleges, the health system, libraries, athletics, and multiple centers. Total fundraising from corporate and foundation sources exceeded \$10 million annually. Prior to joining Temple, Jaime served as the Director of Corporate and Foundation Giving at Easter Seals of Southeastern Pennsylvania for three years.

Jaime began her professional career lobbying local, state, and federal elected officials and agencies as an advocate for the Maritime Exchange for the Delaware River and Bay, which was followed by her tenure with United States Senator Rick Santorum where she served as the Director of Community and Economic Development in his Southeastern Pennsylvania Office.

Jaime received her B.A. in Political Science from La Salle University and holds a Master's Degree in Government Administration from the University of Pennsylvania. A resident of Philadelphia, Jaime is an active member of the community through various civic and professional affiliations, which includes serving as the Chair of the Board of Directors for the Association of Fundraising Professionals – Greater Philadelphia Chapter, a Trustee for The Scholarship Foundation of the Union League of Philadelphia, and a member of the Board of Directors for the Delaware County SPCA.
