Creating an environment where young children thrive


How can we create an environment where children thrive? How could we be more mindful of our interactions with children? Here are 3 simple strategies to implement!

Strategy #1. Creating a Yes! Environment: Positive Interactions and Guidance

- Tour your home as a child would
- Create an environment that works for you without limiting exploration and child creativity
- Ensure safety and respect for items avoid danger and destruction
- Create a catchphrase to support positive interactions
 - Mistakes Help Us Learn; Explore, Dream, Discover
- Sit back, relax, and enjoy

Strategy #2 - Encourage a Growth Mindset vs. a Fixed Mindset





How can we encourage this kind of mindset in children?

Create a family growth mindset jar - decorate the jar, write examples of things to say to promote a growth mindset or examples of what growth mindset is and add to your jar, pull out an example or a saying each day and practice it, teach the children, etc.

- 1. Sense of belonging We all want you to learn, and we all share our knowledge and skills.
- 2. Showing vulnerability It's OK to make mistakes -- it's how we learn.
- 3. Having a Shared Purpose/Vision using catchphrases. "We're a team!", "Everybody has something to share!"
