William L. Baldwin, Esquire, is the Executive Director of the Delaware County Bar Association. Prior to assuming this position in January, 2011, Bill worked for over 20 years as an attorney in the non-profit sector. From 1993-2000, he was the Legal Services Manager of the Domestic Abuse Project of Delaware County; from 2000-2003, he served as the Managing Attorney of the legal services program of A Woman's Place in Bucks County; and from 2003-2010, Bill was the Legal Services Director and from 2010-2011 the Deputy Director at Laurel House, a domestic violence program in Montgomery County.
