In addition, Kevin worked on the front lines of municipal government, spearheading the Administration's efforts on issues and projects in a wide variety of areas, including housing, environmental safety, Internet access, and graffiti removal.

Prior to serving in the Rendell Administration, Kevin practiced law in Philadelphia at Drinker Biddle & Reath, and at Clark Ladner Fortenbaugh & Young. Before that, he worked as a journalist in the Greater Philadelphia region, including stints at *The News-Journal* in Wilmington, Delaware, and *The Philadelphia Journal*.
