Senator Tom McGarrigle was elected to represent the 26th District in November 2014.

He is Vice Chairman of the Senate Local Government Committee. In addition, he serves on the following Senate committees: Aging and Youth, Banking and Insurance, Communications and Technology, and Community, Economic and Recreational Development.

McGarrigle has been a resident of Delaware County for more than 30 years and is a successful small business owner and job-creator.
